**Re: Final Approval Letter: Request to Reopen Licensed Child Care Program**

Dear YMCA Child Care Center at Stony Brook :

The Department of Early Education and Care (“EEC”) has completed its review of your request for approval to reopen and operate your Large Group program and has determined that you have met all of the necessary requirements. This letter shall serve as notice that your program has received **FINAL APPROVAL** to reopen, and you may begin or continue to provide child care as outlined in your reopening application.

**You must post this Final Approval Letter next to your current license.**

Please note you must comply with the **Massachusetts Child and Youth Serving Programs Reopen Approach: *Minimum Requirements for Health and Safety*** (“Minimum Requirements”).

In addition to adhering to the Minimum Requirements, please note that you must still comply with EEC’s licensing regulations; however, certain regulations are not in effect right now. A list of regulations that are not in effect are included on EEC’s website.

Please note that your licensor may contact you at any time to schedule a virtual monitoring visit to ensure compliance with the Minimum Requirements and applicable provisions of EEC’s licensing regulations.



Your program is approved to reopen with the number of groupings indicated in your reopening application or up to the number of groupings your program can safely serve under the Minimum Requirements but not exceeding your licensed capacity within the space outlined on your reopening application. Any new space outlined in your reopening application and approved following a virtual visit is approved for use through the expiration of COVID-19 Order No. 36, the Governor’s Childcare Provider Reopening Preparedness Executive Order.

Any conditions on your license prior to the mandated COVID-19 closure shall remain in effect as long as they are not prohibited under the Minimum Requirements. If you have any questions, please contact your licensor.
